

I OPENING REMARKS/REVIEW OF MINUTES/APPROVAL:

OPENING: Bob opened the Meeting at 7:30 pm.

REVIEW OF MINUTES: Andy said he e-mailed the 10/11/16 Board Meeting Minutes and said he received two revision comments, which he revised. Motion made to approve the 10/11/16 Board Meeting Minutes as revised. Motion passed 6-0-0.

II <u>OLD BUSINESS:</u>

CRIME WATCH: Lt. Mark Meil (Sheriff's Dept.) handed out the Calls for Service for the period of 10/7 to 11/7/16, and said there were 31 calls for service in the local area, which generated 5 reports, 3 in Cloverfields. There was 1 burglary and 1 domestic. 1st Sgt. Bowser (MTA) informed the Board that the Bridge Walk/Run on November 6 went well. He said they received some complaints about closing Route 8, and he said they will re-consider the closure for next year's event. Sgt. Bowser mentioned that they are collecting Toys for Tots once again this year.

NETTLE NET: Bob thanked Jay, Tommy, Bob Sams, and Cindy Ogden for helping him with removing the Nettle Net from the River.

III OFFICER/COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1st Vice President: CONSTRUCTION REVIEW: Jim said he will send a letter to the owner who constructed a fence on Petinot and Monroe Manor without a variance from the Board. The owner was asked to come to the Board Meeting and did not show up.

2nd Vice President: POOL: Court said the Pool cover has been ordered and is waiting delivery. She said Pearl Contracting will be working on the tile, coping and steps. She mentioned that the Halloween parade went well with lots of kids. Court said Jay will be blowing out the water lines in the Pool House.

Treasurer: Jeanette said all the bills are paid to date.

Financial Recorder: Cindy said she will do some test runs on the online payment method. She also said she has re-designed the annual dues billing form which she passed around the Board to see.

Corresponding Secretary: Vacant.

Member-At-Large I: CRIME WATCH: Russ not present, no report. Member-At-Large II: PLAYGROUND: Grant not present, no report.

Member-At-Large III: BEACH: Jay said there were some logs lodged in the Nettle Net which tore the Net. Bob said we will need to bring in some sand for the Beach next season because the recent storm took a lot of the sand away.

Member-At-Large IV: Vacant.

Recording Secretary: CLUBHOUSE: Andy said he continues replacing the burnt Clubhouse light bulbs with LED light bulbs. He said he will re-program the thermostats to winter mode, and will add instructions to the renters on how to use the thermostats without affecting the programming.

IV NEW BUSINESS:

CAR STICKERS: The Board agreed on yellow for the car stickers next year.

TREES: Bob thanked Craig Patterson for removing the 2 dead trees from the Community field. SECURITY CAMERAS: Bob thanked Ed Nolan and Dan Boland for helping him pull the cables from the Beach to the Clubhouse for the security cameras.

V. ADJOURNMENT:

Meeting adjourned at 8:35 pm.
