Pool Manager Position Opening

The Cloverfields pool has an opening for the Pool Manager position. Responsibilities and requirements include:

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the safety and supervision of pool facility, staff, members and guests, supplies and equipment.
- Responsible for pool instructional and special event programs and customer service.
- Responsible for pool revenue, post-season inventory, and collection of equipment.
- Responsible for management of operations with Health Department, pool service companies, phone services, etc., as required.
- Responsible for supervision of staff, the pool areas, and all persons using pool facilities.
- Responsible for operation of pool filtration system and emergency action plans.
- Responsible for supervision of and participation in staff in-service emergency drills and staff training.
- Responsible for accurately completing appropriate paperwork.
- Must be able to work with minimal supervision.

Requirements:

- Must have current American Red Cross Lifeguard Training/ First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer/AED certifications.
- Must be Certified Pool Operator or have Aquatic Facility Operator certification.
- Must be able to work other than normal hours and be available to work as scheduled based upon the needs of the pool.
- Must attend all staff training sessions.
- Must be 21 years of age or older.

I OPENING REMARKS/REVIEW OF MINUTES/APPROVAL:

OPENING: Bob opened the Meeting at 7:30 pm.

REVIEW OF MINUTES: Andy said he e-mailed the draft 10/10/17 Board Meeting Minutes to all Board Members and said he received 2 comments which he corrected. Motion made to approve the 10/10/17 Board Meeting Minutes as revised. Motion passed 5-0-0.

II OLD BUSINESS:

CRIME WATCH: There were no attendees from the Sheriff's Dept. present. Sgt. Bowser of the MTA Police said that he did not hear of any complaints regarding the Bay Bridge Run that was held on 11/5/17. Bob mentioned that traffic seemed to flow well around the event.

SWIM TEAM: Deidre updated the Board on the following Swim Team Committee actions and activities: working on the draft of the Standard Operating Procedures; developing a Swim Meet Schedule; the 11/3/17 fundraiser at the Clubhouse; revisions to the required experience for coaches; and revisions to the requirements for all parents to volunteer in some capacity.

III OFFICER/COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1st Vice President: CONSTRUCTION REVIEW: Jim not present, no report.

2nd Vice President: Bob said Bill Boyle is interested in filling this vacant position. Bill introduced himself and said he is retired and has served on other Boards in smaller communities for the last 20 or more years. The Board welcomed Bill and Bob said that this term would be for one year until the next election cycle. POOL: Bob said the Pool has been winterized and covered for the winter. WOMEN'S CLUB: Bob said Courtney would continue being involved in the Women's Club. The Board thanked Courtney for her many years of service to Cloverfields.

Treasurer: Jeanette handed out Financial Statements ending on October 31, 2017. She volunteered to help with the Christmas Light Contest judging.

Financial Recorder: Cindy said there are 5 properties for sale so far in November. She said she received an inquiry from a member regarding the Betterment Committee, but was unable to attend this meeting. Bob said he ordered 2,000 car stickers, and 2,500 (multi-year) boat/trailer stickers. He said the car stickers will be purple this year.

Corresponding Secretary: Marisa said she was getting up to speed with Cindy regarding the website, and will contact Kathy on how the Newsletter scheduling for items, ads and publishing is handled. She said she received an inquiry for a pest control ad.

Member-At-Large I: CRIME WATCH: Russ not present, no report.

Member-At-Large II: Meredith said she was glad to serve the Board and is ready to help out.

Member-At-Large III: BEACH: Jay not present, no report.

Member-At-Large IV: Penny was unable to attend due to surgery.

Recording Secretary: CLUBHOUSE: Andy said the Clubhouse floors will be professionally cleaned on 11/7/17. He said he will come up with instructions on how to use the propane stove and cooking appliances. He said he was unaware of any rentals requesting use of them to date.

IV NEW BUSINESS:

POOL MANAGER: Bob said the Pool Manager's open position will be advertised in the next Newsletter. A suggestion was also made to place the advertisement on our website.

POOL CONCRETE DECK: Bob said he is in the process of getting bids to replace the remaining old concrete deck slabs around the Pool. He said about half have been replaced in recent years.

MARINA COMMITTEE: Bob said several CPOA Members have approached him volunteering to help with the Marina Committee.

Pool Pass Information: You **Must** have your photo taken if you are new to Cloverfields (everyone in the family), or if you have not taken a digital photo on our system or if you have a new family member (babies must have photo ID) or if your children need a new photo every two years (under five years old needs a picture yearly). If we have your digital photos on file, we will mail your pre-printed Membership/Beach/Pool ID's back with your receipt. Or you can collect them if you pay in person at the Clubhouse in February. **Vehicle Stickers: You must have a current registration to obtain vehicle stickers.** Two stickers per household, **additional stickers \$5 each.** You can pick them up in person on a dues collection day, or mail copies of the registration in to receive stickers by mail. **Boat Stickers: \$35** for the first sticker, and \$20 each additional vessel. Available for pick up on clubhouse dues collection day, or by mail. **You must have current registration for the vessel to obtain sticker. Must be paid separately from HOA Dues. Renters need their own form and must pay \$160 renter fee with signed lease.**
