I. OPENING REMARKS/REVIEW OF MINUTES/APPROVAL:

OPENING: Bob opened the Meeting at 7:35 pm.

REVIEW OF MINUTES: Andy said he e-mailed the draft 2/12/19 Board Meeting Minutes to all Board Members and said he said he received one comment. Motion made to approve the 2/12/19 Board Meeting Minutes as revised. Motion passed 5-0-0.

II. OLD BUSINESS:

CRIME WATCH: Sgt. Hampton said he was filling in for Lt. Johnson who was on another assignment. He said in the last 30 days the following numbers for Cloverfields: there were 72 calls for service which included 40 traffic incidents, 2 patrol checks, 1 noise complaint and 1 overdose. He said opioids continue being a problem in the County. The Board discussed possibly hosting another drug awareness program in the Clubhouse in the future. Bob said he attended a Crime Watch meeting at Queens Landing who discussed a walk-your-dog activity patrol in the neighborhood to encourage Crime Watch participation.

Pool Update: New Pool Management this Summer

This summer the Cloverfields pool will be under new management. The CPOA Board of Directors hired Premier Pool Management Inc. to manage and maintain the pool. If you are interested in applying for a position as a lifeguard, contact Premier Pool Management Inc.: <u>www.premierswim.com</u>.

Pool Rules

*No pool photo i.d. – no entry.

- *No pets or glass.
- * No smoking

1.Guest policy: \$3.00 per person per day. Guest must wear a paid wristband. Guests will be limited during high occupancy (80% of pool capacity)

2. All children 10 years or younger must have an adult, 18 years or older in attendance who is required to stay in the pool area with the child. All children 11 years or older are allowed in the pool by themselves (must pass a swim test).

3. The baby pool is reserved for children under the age of 6. All children must have an adult in attendance with them at all times in the baby pool area. Babies and children not toilet trained must wear swim diapers to swim in the baby or main pool.

- 4. Adult swim is 15 minutes before every hour. 18 years and older.
- 5. No running, rough playing in the pool area, or diving in the shallow end where marked.
- 6. No cut offs, no street clothes in the pool.
- 7. Lifeguard may require you to pass a swim test for deep end swimming.
- 8. Please clean up after yourselves.
- 9. Umbrella's must be put down when the wind picks up; users are responsible for the damage.
- 10. CPOA is not responsible for any injuries or theft and reserves the right to close the pool at any time.
- 11. You will be asked to leave if you fail to comply with any of the rules.

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
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
