I. OPENING REMARKS/REVIEW OF MINUTES/APPROVAL:

OPENING: Bob opened the Meeting at 7:38 pm.

REVIEW OF MINUTES: Andy said he was out of town last meeting and thanked Bob for recording the April 9, 2019 Minutes which Andy said he wrote from Bob's notes and the recording. He said he e-mailed the Minutes to all the Board Members and received one comment which he revised. Motion made to approve the 4/9/19 Board Meeting Minutes as revised. Motion passed 5-0-0.

II. OLD BUSINESS:

CRIME WATCH: Lt. Johnston said in the last 30 days, there were 48 calls for service, 27 of which were traffic related. He said there was 1 assault, 1 overdose (non-fatal), 1 theft and 1 DUI. Duke said to call 410-758-TIPS (8477) to report any suspicious activity. He said anyone can call in tag numbers of speeders and drunk drivers.

III. OFFICER/COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1st Vice President: MARINA: Bill said the snow/sand fence worked well keeping sand out of the channel this winter, and that the fence has been removed.

2nd Vice President: Courtney present, no report.

Treasurer: Jeanette handed out the Financial Statements ending on April 30. Jeanette said she mailed out over 900 Newsletters. SNACK SHACK: Jeanette said the Snack Shack is ready for the opening.

Financial Recorder: Vacant.

Corresponding Secretary: WEBSITE: Marisa said that Vinny is staying on longer volunteering to continue to enhance the CPOA website. SWIM TEAM: Marisa said that up to 50 swimmers have registered so far and that the first practice is scheduled on 6/4.

Member-At-Large I: CRIME WATCH: Russ said no call this month.

Member-At-Large II: Skip said the ID card processing has been going well. Bob thanked Skip for taking on that responsibility.

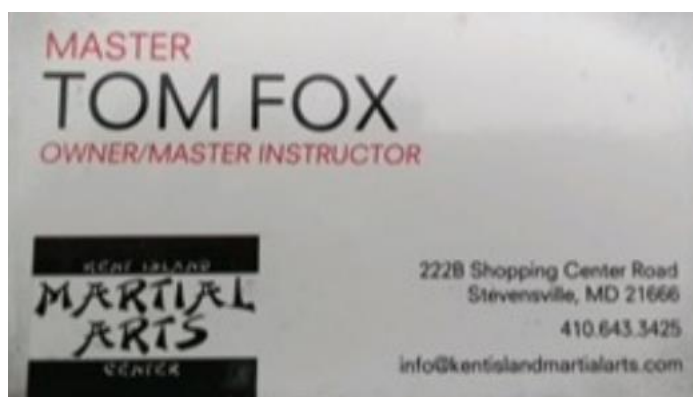
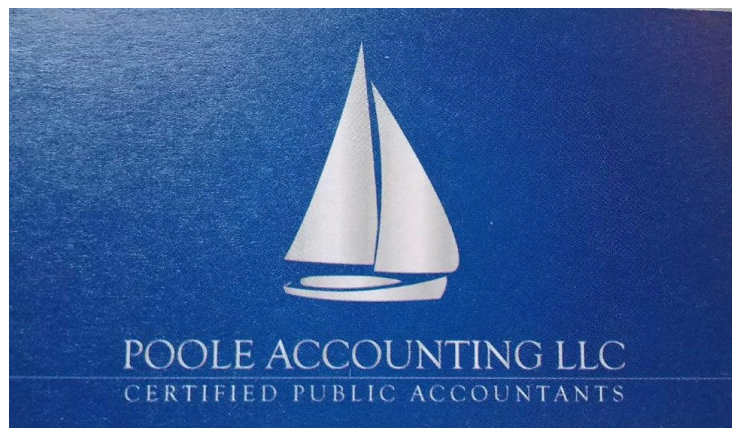
