### Swim Team Registration is Open Now!

You can find the Registration form on the Cloverfields website: <u>www.cloverfields.org/swim-team-information</u>. (Online option to register and pay coming soon.)

<u>Who</u>: Children ages 5 to 18 and must be a Cloverfields Resident. Each swimmer must be able to swim one length of the pool.

<u>What:</u> Swim Team is about perfecting swim strokes: Breast, Butterfly, Back and Crawl, aka: Freestyle. It is all about practice and then showing off your skills at a competitive swim meets.

<u>When:</u> Swim team starts in June and goes through the end of July. Practice times are still being finalized. Those listed below are likely times based on previous years. Evening practices MAY be added if sufficient, sustained interest exists.

Ages 8 and Under: 7:45am to 8:20am Ages 9 & Up: 8:20 to 9:00am

<u>Where:</u> Practice will be at our Community Pool. Most Swim Meets will be at our pool, other meets we will travel to the other team's nearby facilities. An official meet schedule will not be finalized with Delmarva Swim Association until mid-May. We will post as soon as possible.

<u>About Our Swim Team Coaches</u>: Coaches Peggy Miller and Rebecca Pope will join us again this summer to lead the Stingrays in their strokes.

<u>Swim Team Fee:</u> A logo Swim Cap is included for each registered & paid child. (Team Suit is required; suit sizing dates & information to come)

### **CPOA Sticker Placement**

### Vehicle, Trailers and Watercraft

All stickers must be for the current year; no past year stickers will be accepted for any reason. All stickers must be permanently affixed to all vehicles, trailer and watercraft by removing the paper on the back of each sticker and affixing it to the correct location. Tape or any other means is not acceptable.

Sticker locations are as follows:

- <u>Watercraft</u> left side of hull or window area left side.
- <u>Trailers</u> left side forward tong area or winch post, please do not put them behind anything that will obstruct the view of the sticker.
- <u>Vehicles</u> left side windshield upper/lower area is acceptable. The reason for the left side is for the purpose that when entering the beach, the guards and others can see this for easy identification.


